NOTICE

All students of the II, IV, VI, and VIII semester of the Academic Session 2025–26 are hereby informed that they must mandatorily fill out their Examination Form by **10 April 2026**.

While filling out the Examination Form, students are required to follow the instructions given below:

1. Students cannot select a GE (Generic Elective) subject from the same course in which they are currently enrolled.
2. Students who have already studied GE, SEC, and VAC in previous semesters cannot opt for them again.
3. Do not select subjects that are not offered by any department of Rajdhani College.
4. For B.A. students:
 - Those who have opted for a language as a core subject must study a second language in Semesters I and III.
 - Those who do not have a language as a core subject must study one language in Semesters I and III, and another language in Semesters II and IV.
5. Students can apply for improvement only for the previous even semester. For example, VI Semester students can apply for improvement only in the IV Semester.
6. Fill in only those subjects in the Examination Form that were selected through the Google Form, to avoid discrepancies in attendance, internal assessment, tutorials, and practical marks (please refer rajdhani college website for updated GE, SEC & VAC list).
7. Do not submit the Examination Form with only Improvement and ER (Essential Repeat) subjects; subjects of the current semester must also be included.
8. Students who have ER in the previous even semester must complete re-registration; otherwise, they will be responsible for any discrepancies.
9. Internal assessment and tutorial marks are available on the Samarth Portal, and practical marks are indicated as N/R. If N/A is displayed instead of N/R, students must contact the administrative office.
10. While filling out the Examination Form, students must verify subject codes from the Date Sheet available on the University of Delhi website. If multiple codes exist for a subject, select the correct code carefully.
11. Students studying MIL (Modern Indian Language) in another college must ensure that their internal assessment, tutorial, and practical marks are submitted to Rajdhani College on time.
12. Subjects meant exclusively for specialized/vocational courses must not be selected by B.A. students.
13. Students of II and IV semesters must select AEC subjects based on their prior qualification in the following order:

- Hindi-A (Class 12 level)
- Hindi-B (Class 10 level)
- Hindi-C (Class 8 level)
- Sanskrit (Class 12 level)
- Sanskrit (Class 10 level)
- Sanskrit (Class 8 level)

All students are further advised to attend classes of their approved subjects regularly and begin their academic work. If any student fills subjects different from those selected, they will be solely responsible for the consequences.

Note: Students will be held responsible for any discrepancies arising due to failure to comply with the above instructions within the stipulated time.
